The workshops will focus on technique, different mediums, elements of design and culture. ### Friday, January 15<sup>th</sup>- Gyotaku-The Japanese Art of Fish Printing

-Using fragile rice paper, textured paint and replicas of realistic fish, children will make prints in the ancient Japanese style.

### Friday, January 29<sup>th</sup>- Polaroid Emulsion Transfers and Self-Portraits

-Children will learn the art of composition by taking a self portrait using a Polaroid camera. They will then transfer the developing photo onto watercolor paper, creating unique effects and dreamlike qualities.

### Friday, February 5<sup>th</sup>-Musical Canvas Loom Weaving

-Children will listen to many different genres of music, then create an abstract composition using acrylic paint, canvas, wooden dowels and weaving.

### Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>- Beaded Wire Tree Sculpture

-Children will choose a tree of their choice, and then create it using copper or silver wire. They will attach brightly colored beads, and construct a miniature sculpture mounted on rock.
