- SPHS/MS Career Fair, got 6 LG recruit contacts


Financial & GRANTS








Platform and device breakdown

ISSUES + CONCERNS

Maintenance & Repairs

- Roof leak
 - Work order placed with maintenance to fill gap (see picture below), should be complete next week, as long as maintenance tech is comfortable with the heights
- Pool
 - Lower sand filter was capped off (see picture below) due to leak and inability to replace filter or parts, as they are obsolete.
 - Maintenance procedures/flow compliance have been tested and passed
 - Need to re-route water flow to prevent over pressurizing main pump
 - Andrew from Tolin to provide quote asap
 - Will be replacing flex tubing with rigid PVC to reduce friction/buildup and maximize chemical feeding efficiency
 - o Fountain feature motor will need to be replaced, not a priority
